

View/Print Label

1. **Ensure there are no other shipping or tracking labels attached to your package.** Select the Print button on the print dialogue box that appears. Note: If your browser does not support this function, select Print from the File menu to print the label.
2. **Customs Invoice** - 3 copies of a completed customs invoice are required for shipments with a commercial value.
3. **Fold the printed label along the solid line below.** Place the label in a UPS Shipping Pouch. If you do not have a pouch, attach the folded label using clear plastic shipping tape over the entire label.
4. **GETTING YOUR SHIPMENT TO UPS**
 - Customers without a scheduled Pickup**
 - o Ground, 3 Day Select and Standard to Canada shipments must be dropped off at an authorized UPS location, or handed to a UPS driver. Pickup service is not available for these services. To find the nearest UPS location, visit ups.com.
 - o To Schedule a pickup or find a UPS location, visit ups.com
 - Customers with a scheduled Pickup**
 - o Your driver will pick up your shipment(s) as usual.
